(1) Consultation before taking service: 5,000 yen/60 min or 7,000 yen/90 min

(2) Service Type (of the Supervised Visitation):

Type	Service
Accompaniment Type Visitation Service	When a parent who live together with his/her child has an uneasy feeling about visitation between the child and the other parent, this accompaniment type visitation service can be used. This service can be used only the parent. His/her own house is prohibited to use for this supervised visitation. This service can be used only once a month at most 3 hours.
	Fee: 15,000 yen -25,000 yen
Delivering Type Visitation Service	When a parent who live together with his/her child is not willing to see the other parent, this delivering type visitation service can be used. The child is delivered from the parent who live together to the other parent based upon the contract between the parents. This service can be used only once a month.
	Fee: 10,000 yen (by 4 hours) – 15,000 yen (by 7 hours)

Rule of the Visitation

1. Scheduling of the Visitation

A parent who does not live together with his/her child and the staff of FPIC will choose the visitation day and time among the several days and time the other parent proposes for the visitation.

2. Attendance of the Visitation

The visitation is allowed only for the parent who does not live together with his/her child.

Without permission of the FPIC staff, the grand parents of the child cannot attend the visitation.

3. Present

Present is prohibited to give for the child.

4. Usage of Camera and Mobile Phone

It's allowed to take pictures if its number is few.

Do not to expose the child's picture to the public.

Video recording and audio recording is prohibited.

Refrain from showing the pictures and movies which were taken when the

parent and the child live together to the child.

Calling someone to talk with the child with the mobile phone is prohibited.
